The Camp Counselors lead a small group of 4 – 10 campers throughout a scheduled number of activities throughout the day. The primary goal of the camp counselors is to assist in fostering a safe, memorable, and mission-aligned experience for campers, families, staff, and community.

Qualifications:

Applicants must be 18 or older, undergo a background check, and take camp required training

- Ability to work with children, connecting to the age group assigned for the week
- Readiness to jump into activities as the main leader for assigned campers
- Willing to nurture children’s desire to explore under watchful, safe supervision
- Prior experience as a summer camp counselor or leadership with children preferred
- Maturity, enthusiasm, flexibility, and a love of children and the outdoors

The Camp Counselor duties will include, but not be limited to the following

- Able and willing to work all summer sessions
- Work closely with Camp Director and support staff to execute provided programming and camp day-to-day schedule of activities
- Work with campers, staff, and other partners to execute and provide a fun, safe and exciting camp experience
- Assist programming specialist with activities
- Regular reporting to Camp Director to include daily timesheets
- Assist in daily set up and clean up
- Notify Camp Director of any supply item that is low
- Post camp clean-up as scheduled
- Encouraging & engaging campers to embrace all activities of camp by sharing your gifts, knowledge and joy of nature and art with campers
